Sonship

In 1967 Johannes Werner Klein, who died in 1984 - he was the one who, together with a fellow student at the time, had posed the decisive question to Rudolf Steiner that led to the founding of the Christian Community, but who then 'threw it all in' after a few years, resigned from his position as supreme leader, left the Christian Community as well as the Anthroposophical Society and became a private scholar - published his very important book on the subject of sonship - the subject of this essay - "You Are Gods", which has since then, as far as I can see, hardly been equaled in beauty, intellectual brilliance and depth. - However, with this very beautiful book he did not come close to Rudolf Steiner, despite its depth in certain respects, if only because he, unlike Rudolf Steiner, did not work out the most important point in this respect for our present time, namely the question of how one can meditatively reach Sonship in concrete terms.

This highly promising, difficult and human development-significant topic of "sonship" - how could one best describe this term coming from the theological field?

Sonship is - sketchily speaking - about becoming a human being, about working oneself out of the immature, dependent, unfree state of soul and becoming a son, friend, co-worker of the gods (1), (2).
